Not fulfilling this commitment in full could void any agreements between you and the ECHO Cohort Consortium to complete your ancillary study. \*

## Institutional Review Board (IRB)

Please note, if the planned ancillary study involves human subjects research, the ECHO Coordinating Center requires documentation of IRB approval. For projects not involving human subjects' research or considered exempt research, the ECHO CC requires documentation of exemption.

- Current ECHO Investigators: Provide a copy of the current ECHO sIRB approval.
- Non-ECHO Investigators: Obtain local IRB approval or documentation showing the project doesn't require review (e.g., exempt or non-human subjects research).
